The surrounding waters include the Mid-Atlantic Ocean up to 10 miles offshore out of the Ocean City Inlet, the Assawoman Bay and the Isle of Wight Bay. This service can accommodate up to six passengers / scuba divers.

We can also offer a “themed” charter trip option for the members and supporters of your organization that you host and manage yourselves on our boat. In this option, you would charge whatever you wanted for the “themed” trip and keep the proceeds for your non-profit after deducting the discounted charter boat costs that we would charge for the boat, captain and crew service.
